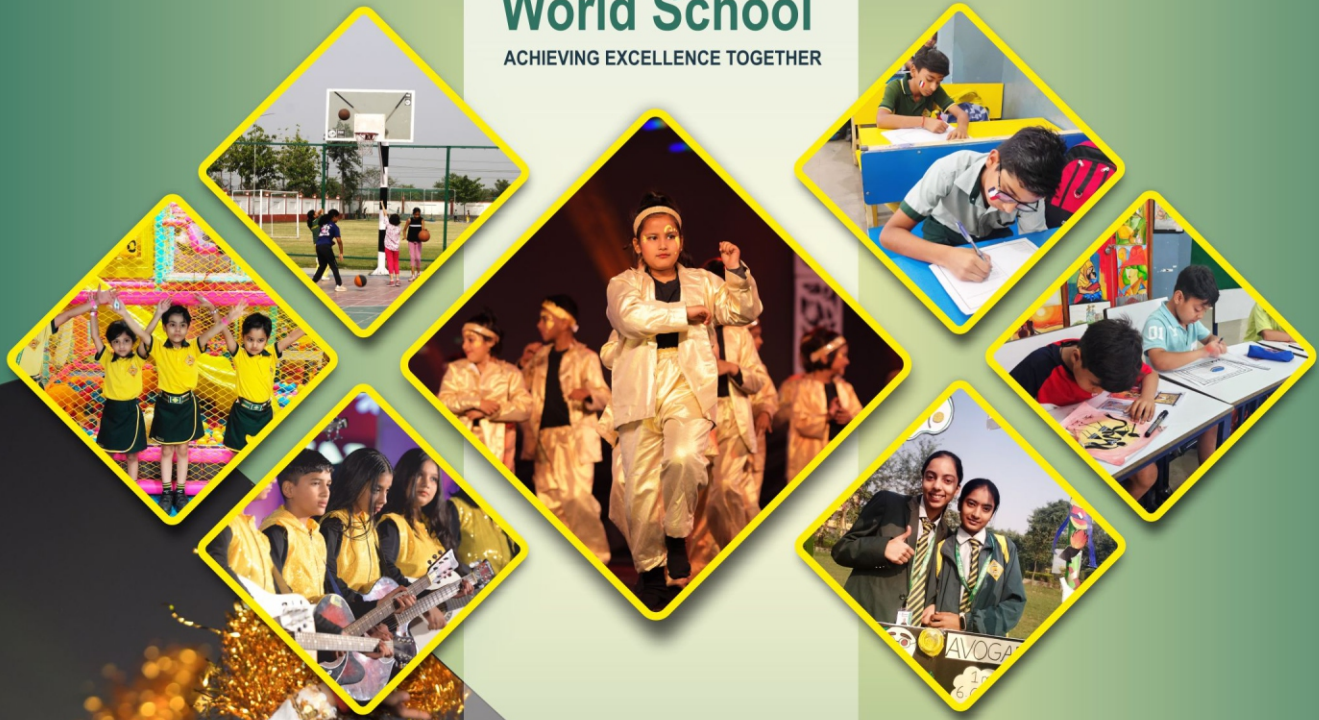

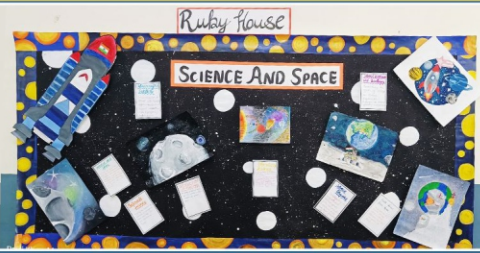

6th September 2025

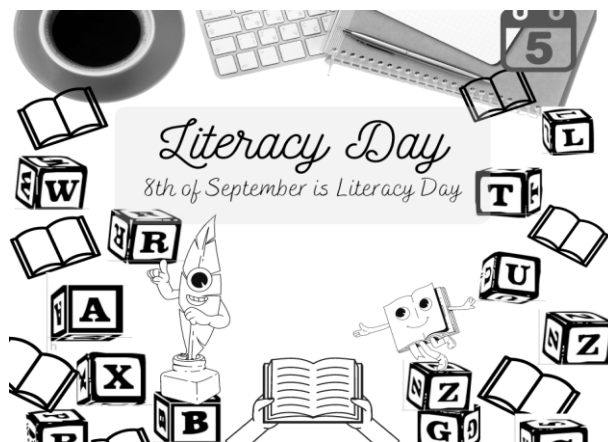


A special Grandparents' Day Celebration was organized for Nursery to Class II. The event emphasized awareness of family values, traditions, and intergenerational learning.

By fostering informed perspectives and meaningful engagement, the school continues to uphold its enduring motto: Achieving Excellence Together.

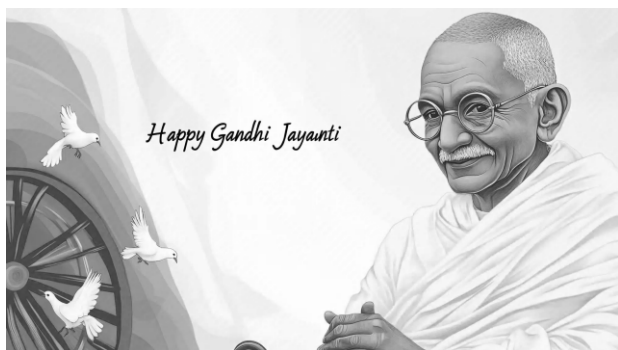
Happenings of the Month – October 2025

To promote experiential learning beyond classroom boundaries, the school organized educational excursions:

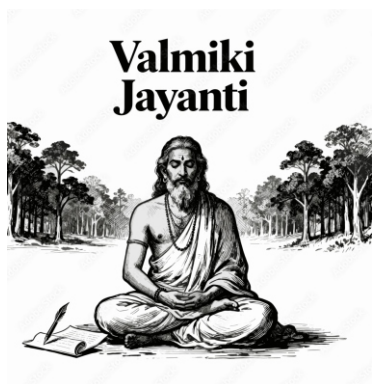

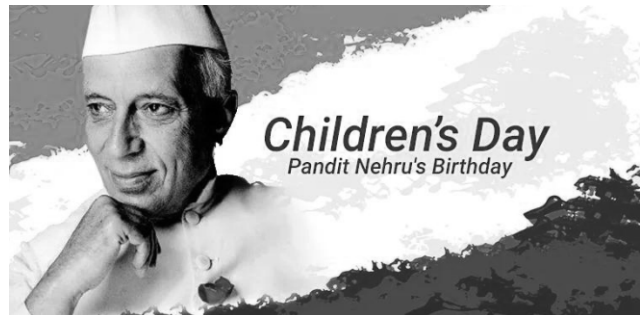
20th November 2025 – SOF International Social Science Olympiad (Classes III–VIII)

14th November 2025

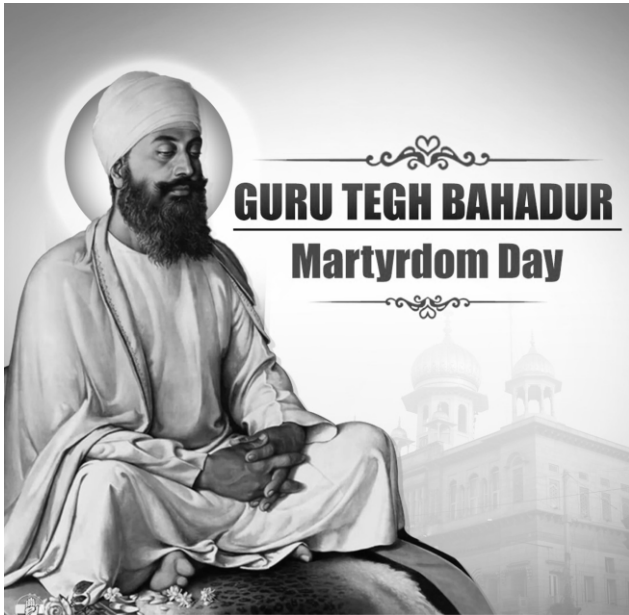

The smooth conduct of examinations reflected the disciplined academic framework of the institution and the students' sincere preparation.

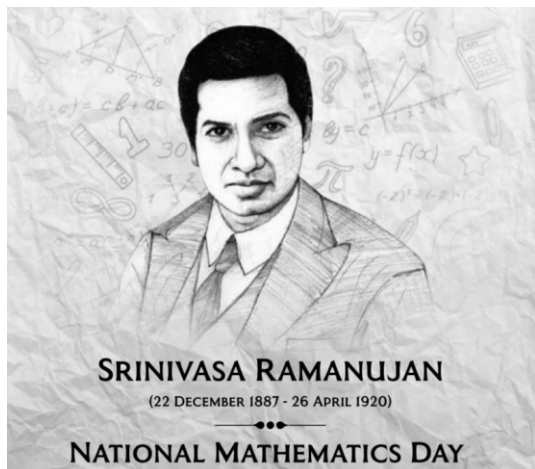
Orientation Programme: "Sharing is Caring" (Up to Junior Wing)

Happenings of the Months – February & March 2026

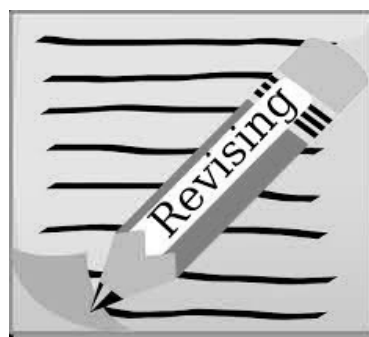
Achieving Excellence Together

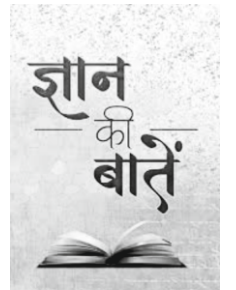

यहाँ का भोजन भी सादा और स्वादिष्ट होता है। चावल, नारियल से बने व्यंजन और दक्षिण भारतीय पकवान यहाँ अधिक प्रचलित हैं। गोकर्ण प्राकृतिक सुंदरता और धार्मिक आस्था का सुंदर संगम है। यहाँ का शांत वातावरण, सुंदर समुद्र तट और धार्मिक परंपराएँ इसे एक विशेष पर्यटन स्थल बनाती हैं। हमें ऐसे स्थानों की यात्रा करके उनकी संस्कृति और परंपराओं का सम्मान करना चाहिए। यह स्थान हमें सादगी, शांति और प्रकृति से प्रेम करना सिखाता है।
